Among critically ill patients admitted to an intensive care unit, 11-64% received high-flow oxygen therapy and 47-71% received mechanical ventilation; some hospitalized patients have required advanced organ support with endotracheal intubation and mechanical ventilation (4-42%).[3-4,9] A small proportion have also been supported with extracorporeal membrane oxygenation (ECMO, 3-12%).[3-4,9] Other reported complications include cardiac injury, arrhythmia, septic shock, liver ...
